Provisional Charter of

C. W. Clark Memorial Library

This instrument witnesseth That the Board of Regents for and on behalf of the Education Department of the State of New York has granted this provisional charter
Incorporating

Leon A. Dapson Lloyd W. Clark Walter D. Nash

 Marion R. Gaffney and Stella B. Hamblin

And their associates and successors in office as a free public library, in accordance with the vote establishing the same, under the corporate name of C. W. Clark Memorial Library, to be located in the village of Oriskany Falls, Oneida County, N.Y., the library to have, as provided by law, five trustees, to be at first the persons named herein as incorporators, who are the duly elected library trustees of the village of Oriskany Falls, Oneida County, N.Y. to hold respectively in the order of their naming, as they have determined by lot, for terms that shall expire with the official village year, one each in the years 1939, 1940, 1941, 1942 and 1943, and their successors to hold for terms of five years, to be elected as vacancies occur, in conformity with law, one each year by the Village Board; and this provisional charter will be replaced by an absolute charter if, within five years, the corporation shall have acquired sufficient property available for its use and support and be maintaining, to the satisfaction of the Regents, a library of proper standard.
